Water Taxi Service (River Spirit) along the Assiniboine River run out of the dock at the Forks. <https://www.splashdash.ca/riverspirit.htm>

- Enjoy convenient river transportation to 5 city docks provided by Splash Dash Water Bus. Servicing each dock about every 15 minutes, The River Spirit navigates through the centre of Winnipeg along the historic Red and Assiniboine Rivers.

- The 34 seat red and green Trolley travels on a route from The Forks in downtown Winnipeg to Assiniboine Park Zoo, making stops on a repeated circuit at locations within Assiniboine Park, before returning to The Forks. This route is repeated several times throughout the day. Route maps are posted on signs throughout the Park and at the stop located at Inn at The Forks.

General Information

General Information on alcohol and marijuana laws in the Province of Manitoba:

Cannabis is legal in Canada and government regulated. In Manitoba you must be 19 years of age for purchase and it may not be consumed in public spaces. Refer to <https://www.gov.mb.ca/cannabis/index.html> for more information. There are two locations near downtown.

1. Delta Nine @ 478 River Ave (Osborne Village) (~10-15 minute walk from Hotel Fort Garry)
2. Tokyo Smoke @ 264 McDermot Ave. (~15 minute walk from Hotel Fort Garry)

Alcohol is government regulated and can be purchased at the MLCC (Manitoba Liquor Control Commission) by anyone 18 years or older. Cannot be consumed in public spaces. There are three locations near downtown.

1. MLCC @ 469 River Avenue (Osborne Village) (~10-15 minute walk from Hotel Fort Garry)
2. MLCC @ 333 St. Mary Avenue located in City Place (~5-10 minute walk from Hotel Fort Garry)
3. MLCC @ 21 Marion Street (~10-15 minute walk from Hotel Fort Garry)
